- MML: 1.9M hours worked without a lost time injury (LTI) over 26 months
- ✓ Up to 3500 people working at the site mostly contractors with >16M hours worked total
- ✓ 9.2M hours in last 12 months with a total of 7 LTIs
- ✓ 2015 Lost time injury frequency index 0.74 per million hours worked – better than peers

...the change to operations brings different challenges

Corporate Responsibility: Health



Health management now centralized at the mine...

- ✓ MML doctor and team oversee MML and contractor health
- ✓ Assistance to communities for emergencies (MML assists directly with paramedics and a doctor in Nuevo Balsas)
- ✓ Move to risk-based health management for MML team higher risk, greater level of surveillance



...community assistance continues

Corporate Responsibility: Resettlement



Resettlement of the essential community completed...

- ✓ Resettlement of La Fundición essential for the mining (dump development) completed in Q4 2015
- ✓ Resettlement of Real del Limón should be completed in Q2, 2016 village 98% complete
- ✓ La Fundición community members are personalizing their homes

How to help communities...

- ✓ Formalized, transparent grievance management system implemented
- Community systems being developed with long-term view (requests) for assistance

Corporate Responsibility: Environmental Management

Baseline data completed...

- ✓ Initial monitoring network extensive now focussed on operational control
- ✓ Implementation of plans to address permit requirements (flora rescue)
- Reports submitted to regulators as required by permits
- ✓ No water discharge from site to date
- √ 3rd party asset retirement obligation estimate completed
- ✓ No citations or reports from the regulatory authority

Corporate Responsibility: Environmental Management

Project design provides innovation...

- ✓ Use of the RopeCon reduces the production of GHG and dust
- ✓ Tailings dry stack:
 - ✓ Efficient water management
 - Reduced cyanide management needs
 - ✓ Long-term stable
 - ✓ Initial monitoring network extensive now focussed on operational control
- On-site water management maximizes re-use of water saving cost and local resources
